

ILA 2006 Annual Meeting
University Inn Best Western
Oct. 6, 2006, 9:45-10:45 am

- 1) Meeting called to order at 9:45 am by Laurie Francis (vice-chair elect); 38 individuals were in attendance. *List of those who signed the roll at the end of document.*
- 2) Accomplishments of Division reviewed; no questions or discussion. The vote to accept bylaws as revised was unanimous.
- 3) Goals for next year:
 - a) Phil's goals for 2007 were discussed:
 - i) Types and names of special libraries in Idaho were suggested as follows:
 - (1) State Library (Idaho Commission for Libraries)
 - (2) Medical Librarians at: EIRMC (Idaho Falls), Healthwise (Boise), all other hospitals
 - (3) Technical librarians at: AMI, Micron, INL
 - (4) Legislative library
 - (5) Museums: Basque Library in Boise, county museums
 - (6) Historical societies
 - (7) Genealogical libraries
 - (8) Church libraries
 - ii) How to get them more involved in ILA?
 - (1) They have smaller budgets and affording membership and costs of attendance are a concern for them
 - (2) Special Library Association is strong and active and could be competition for ILA
 - iii) What could they bring to ILA?
 - (a) Diversity
 - (b) More importantly- we need to consider what we could do for them:
 - (c) *Help with cataloging questions*
 - (d) *Find workshops that would help them since they're so specialized, such as:*
 - (i) How to keep up with technology
 - (ii) Learn about archives and preservation techniques
 - (iii) Cataloging small donated collections
 - (e) *Provide speakers from ILA for their luncheons or regular meetings*
 - (f) *Share book reviews of helpful sources*
 - b) Other goals suggested:
 - i) Host or plan a joint meeting with special committees
 - (1) Plan a separate meeting or retreat for just the Academic Division and invite special libraries to attend. We could go into more depth on various topics applicable to

academic libraries. Have sessions longer than one hour. Do not just add an extra day onto annual conference, make it separate. Concern was expressed that academic librarians might not attend the annual or regional meetings if we had a separate meeting. Plan a retreat with the focus on just one area or track- public services, technical services.

- ii) Look for co-sponsors- PNLA or medical libraries for Academic sessions
- iii) Plan a web conference on special topics
- iv) Increase membership and participation in academic division
 - (1) Ideas: target individuals, address benefits of joining, encourage their institutions to help defray membership costs (costs of attending conference are often reimbursed by institutions but not actual membership fee)
- v) Establish an electronic newsletter with sections for various areas (i.e. cataloging)
- vi) Get representation from all academic institutions at next ILA

5) Upcoming cataloging training at BSU July 18-19, 2007- Barbara Glackin

- a) They hope to have 30+ people attend, the LCSH cataloging instruction may apply to some of the public and school libraries, training will be affordable, conducted by two trainers, one of whom is coming from Washington, might consider having a session to explain cataloging to reference people. (Cathy Gray suggested we hold the Academic division retreat at the same time as the catalog training)

6) Ideas for 2007 ILA workshops:

- a) How to use End Notes or something more general. Mike Pollastro volunteered to teach this.
- b) How to use: CiteUlike, RefWorks. Suggested that we could ask Professor David Hall, BSU, to teach this one.
- c) Library bibliographic instruction and how to get beyond the search, how to evaluate and assess information
- d) Electronic resource management, ILS management
- e) In-depth discussion of copyright issues, particularly e-reserve issues
- f) In-depth discussion of Google Scholar
- g) Scholarly communication with faculty, why working with faculty is important
 - i) Do adjunct faculty understand library services and what we can do for them
- h) Collection development in the electronic field
- i) What's new at Lili?
- j) How to get staff training vertically and horizontally
- k) Media- beyond print resources, how new types are used or not used. Are we cataloging them?
- l) Institutional repository- linking individual prospects (continuation of Kay Flowers conversation)

7) Personnel changes:

- a) CSI, Steve Poppino: they have three MLS librarians, two from online programs, they are buying lots of e-books, redesigning their Library and Information Science class and putting in online.
- b) BSU, Marilyn Moody: Adrian Taylor, Beverly Mills and Janet (Strong) Davis are retiring, and they have one visiting librarian.
- c) Univ. of Idaho, Susan Mueller: Ben Hunter is their new reference librarian, Dean Ron Force is retiring and Lynn Baird will be the interim dean, due to retirements they are getting new reference and cataloging librarians and a new archivist. Zinthia Brinceno will get her MLS in December.
- d) ISU, Sandi Shropshire: Leonard Hitchcock has retired and there is an opening for an electronic resources librarian.

8) Other business:

- a) We should consider having an informal liaison at each institution from the Academic Division to promote ILA to new librarians; have a membership application and other information to put in the hiring packet from ILA for new librarians.
- b) We need to reach out more to library support staff at the various institutions.
