- Educational Media Division meeting was convened on October 7, 2004 as a session at the ILA Conference.
 - 23 professionals were in attendance.
 - Pam Juel was introduced as the Ed Media Division chair-elect
 - Val Fenske was introduced as State Department of Education's Curriculum Materials Specialist and ILA's Vice President.
 - Business:
 - +October's Annual Report was shared
 - +The "Library Literacy Standards and Idaho Achievement Standards" were introduced by Val Fenske. The document is found at <http://www.sde.state.id.us/instruct/librarymediacenter/>.
 - +The recently updated *School Library Information Manual* was also introduced. Members were told that the two documents were the result of collaboration between ILA, SDE and ISL.
 - +Topics of interest for ILA's 2005 State Conference were brainstormed
 - +Information was shared on upcoming events for professional development of teacher-librarians
- Bryan Burnett, Follett Library Resources, offered to fund a \$500 award to recognize some aspect of school library programs yearly at the State Conference.
- AASL Leadership Institute: Leading through Collaboration generated a lot of excitement for a high-caliber workshop. Nearly all participants chose to write action plans to share with their principals/supervisors. The net result was 23 in attendance; 19 took the class for credit.
- Barbara Barrett, chair of the School Library Media Coalition ad hoc committee, has asked for \$1600 to fund a planning session for a Grass Roots program spearheaded by a librarian in each region of Idaho.
