Chair Activities:

- Fall 2004 ILA Conference
 - The agreement with American Association of School Librarians for the AASL's Leadership Institute: Leading through Collaboration was signed for Oct. 8, 2004. Betty Bankhead is the presenter. The cost is \$4,500.
 - Valerie Fenske and Dan Prinzing with the State Department of Education have agreed to underwrite \$4,000 of the institute. Stephanie Bailey-White of ISL negotiated with the SDOE.
 - Follett Library Resources has been contacted to underwrite the up to \$853 costs for supplies and 96-page notebooks for all participants.
 - Northwest Nazarene University has approved 1 semester credit for \$55 with 15 hours of contact at the Thursday conference and Friday institute plus work outside of class.
 - Linda Brilz will offer a session titled, "It's a Guy Thing: Great Reads for Boys."
 - Gini Carrow's session is titled, "Tips and Tricks for Training Teachers and Other Adults."

- School Library Media Coalition
 - In early February, Barbara Barrett, Coalition Chair, confirmed funding from the SDOE for updating the *School Librarian's Information Manual* (SLIM) and compiling Information Literacy Standards. Valerie Fenske, SDOE Curriculum Technology Center librarian, led the committee on March 19 and April 15-16. Carolyn Mauer, chief of the Bureau of Curriculum and Accountability, explained that the rush on completing the project was so the information literacy component can be distributed to district administrators with this summer's SDOE achievement standards, courses of study, etc.
