The Intellectual Freedom Committee achieved several goals listed under Goal 3 in the ILA Strategic Plan for 2004/05-2006/07.

**Objective 1: Continue to advocate for open access to information for all Idaho residents**

4. We continue to update the Idaho library community on intellectual freedom issues by postings on LIBIDAHO.

6. At the Region 2 conference in Lewiston, Michael Greenlee gave a presentation on the USA PATRIOT Act and policy development.
