

## RESOLUTION for ILA on NON-CONTIGUOUS CONSOLIDATIONS

Whereas, the Idaho Library Association supports the consolidation of city libraries and district libraries to join into larger units of service in order to maximize, leverage and benefit library services, and,

Whereas, in certain situations, city libraries and district libraries that do not share contiguous borders but are in proximity may wish to consolidate, and,

Whereas, the Idaho Library Association continues to support the work of the Law Revision Task Force, and,

Whereas, the Law Revision Task Force has developed a modification to Idaho Code 33-2709 concerning consolidation of non-contiguous city and district libraries to be introduced into the 57<sup>th</sup> Idaho Legislature, Second Regular Session,

Now, Therefore, be it resolved that the Idaho Library Association membership supports the modification of Idaho Code 33-2709 to encompass non-contiguous consolidations of city and district libraries and,

Be it further resolved that ILA membership is urged to contact appropriate legislators to ask their support for the adoption of this modification to Idaho Code.

RESOLUTION for ILA on RAISING LIBRARY DISTRICT TAX CAP TO .10%

Whereas, the Idaho Library Association supports city libraries and district libraries, and,

Whereas, the library district maximum tax levy is lower than the maximum tax levy for city libraries, and,

Whereas, the Idaho Library Association supports the concept of adequate funding for all public libraries in Idaho, and,

Whereas, in certain situations, library districts are not receiving the benefits of growth in the district due to the maximum tax levy limit, and

Whereas, the Idaho Library Association continues to support the work of the Law Revision Task Force, and,

Whereas, the Law Revision Task Force has developed a modification to Idaho Code 33-2724 concerning the tax levy cap for library districts, raising said cap to match that of city libraries, to be introduced into the 57<sup>th</sup> Idaho Legislature, Second Regular Session,

Now, Therefore, be it resolved that the Idaho Library Association membership supports the modification of Idaho Code 33-2724 to provide for a Library District tax levy cap of .10% to match City Libraries, and,

Be it further resolved that ILA membership is urged to contact appropriate legislators to ask their support for the adoption of this modification to Idaho Code.
