The Past President's primary responsibilities focus on building a strong slate of candidates for offices that become open for the approaching year. I have successfully completed that task.

- Offices to be filled in the 2005 election for the new Association year beginning after the annual conference in October included: Vice-President, President-elect; Secretary; and PNLA Representative.
- Candidates for Vice-President, President-elect are: Joe Reiss and Tammy Hawley-House. Candidate for Secretary is Lynn Bidwell. Candidates for PNLA Representative are Laurie Francis and Anne Abrams.
- Ballots went out in mid-June to all members of ILA who had paid dues. Ballots were due back by September 16, giving members the three months required by our By-Laws.
- Ballots were counted after mail received on September 16. 126 ballots were returned and counted. Candidates were notified of the results by phone on Monday, September 18, 2005. Formal announcement of the election results will be made at the first ILA membership meeting in Pocatello on October 6, 2005.
- New officers will take over at the second membership meeting on October 7, 2005 and will conduct their first board meeting on Saturday morning October 8, 2005.
- In addition to recruiting candidates for office, I have consulted with President Greever in person and over the phone many times during the year. Our frequent communication ensured smooth operation of the Association and completion of many tasks this year.
