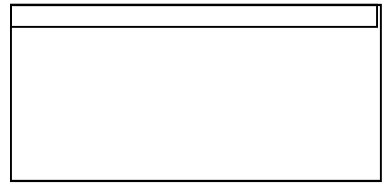
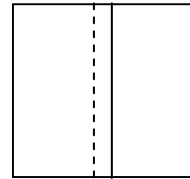


# Folding a newspaper bag

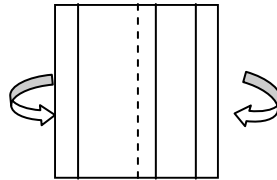
Fold over about  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch along the top edge



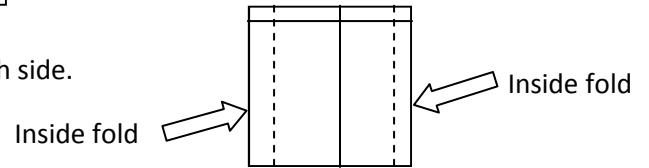
Fold each side to just across the center line so you have about a  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch overlap.



Fold over 1 inch on each side edge. Crease well.

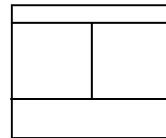


Fold the sides back on the creased line to form an inside fold on each side.



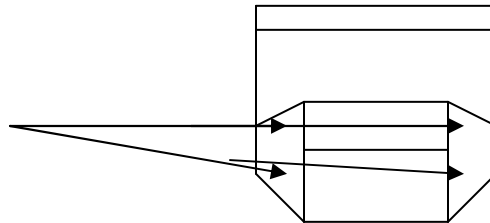
Glue the center seam.

Fold up a little less than 2 inches along the bottom, crease well.



This is the tricky part. You are forming the bottom of the bag. You need open it and flatten it out to look like this:

Glue inside the 4 triangles, and only inside the 4 triangles.



Fold one side of the bottom along the crease and glue just the triangles. Then fold the other side and glue the triangles and a line along the top. It will be easier when you have the bag in hand.
